The 2020 International Maritime Organization **IMO Fuel Sulphur** Regulation

The IMO has enforced a new 0.5% global sulphur cap (down from 3.5%) on ships fuel from the 1st of January 2020.

The fuel sulphur cap is part of the IMO's response to environmental concerns as emissions from ships using dirty fuel produce harmful gases such as CO^2 .

The increased cost to using clean fuel will drive sustainable low-carbon and zero-carbon shipping.
